Footnotes

CAUGHT IN THE RAIN came out at the start bumping GLIA, moved up soon after to force the pace from between foes three or four wide, reached the front in the upper stretch, was headed at the furlong grounds from the outside by BEDANKEN, regained the advantage soon after, then gamely held sway under strong handling. GLIA, bumped at the break by the winner and forced out on HIGH MAINTENANCE (GB), was steadied in tight quarters, settled between rivals to race five or six wide, edged in a bit on the second turn, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and was going well at the end. BEDANKEN gained a forward position early while maneuvering in three or four wide to track the leaders, put a head in front at the furlong grounds, then wasn't quite good enough. HEYAHOHOWDY bobbed sharply soon after the start, settled near the inside, saved ground until the stretch, eased out six wide, then was empty in the late stages. LUSH SOLDIER, within easy striking distance while following the leaders five or six wide, came a bit wider into the lane and flattened out when the test came. HIGH MAINTENANCE (GB), bumped at the start by FIRST QUARTER and forced in on GLIA after the start, forced that one in a bit, was unhurried while angled inside, raced along the hedge around the far turn and into the stretch and was empty the last eighth. MARIENSKY, outrun early and maneuvered in behind horses four wide, reached contention between foes four wide entering the far turn, held on well into the upper stretch but lacked a further account. FIRST QUARTER leaned in at the break bumping HIGH MAINTENANCE (GB), was rated between foes four wide and was not a factor after five furlongs. SHOWLADY, between rivals three or four wide to the end of the backstretch, weakened thereafter. NTOMBI settled four or five wide early, moved out six abreast on the backstretch, then never menaced while coming wider into the stretch. STYLELISTICK gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and weakened thereafter.
