BASTILLE stalked the pace, swung wide near the quarter pole, closed steadily and drove clear. RUNNING TIDE dueled along the rail, gained a clear lead in midstretch and weakened late. FOUFA'S WARRIOR disputed the pace outside RUNNING TIDE and gave way in midstretch. MARAQUERO saved ground and weakened in the drive. STAGE CLASSIC , three wide on the turns, weakened and drifted out late. LONE ARROW raced well off the rail and was no factor.
