Any FTBOA Stakes fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. The Owner of the winner to receive 60%, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 3 lbs; \$25,000 in 2011 or two races other than maiden, claiming or starter, 5 lbs; a race other than claiming, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Closed Saturday, August 13, 2011 with 21 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs).

MUSICAL FLAIR reserved off the pace, rallied between rivals to gain command at the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. MARTINI MADNESS chased the pace along the hedge, slipped through inside BOB'S PLACE to gain the lead approaching the eighth pole but couldn't match strides with the winner late while holding the place. BIG DREAMS chased the pace off the hedge, was steadied from between rivals inside the eighth pole, then recovered and came back on to gain the show. EVERYDAY DAVE pressed the pace three wide into the stretch, came out a few paths and gave way. BOB'S PLACE set the pace under pressure off the hedge into the stretch, then tired. IMPERIAL ROBYN off slowly, failed to menace. MOOR OF VENICE was no factor after hitting the gate at the start. SEVEN KIND rated off the pace, faltered. LARGE KAUFY was outrun after breaking a step slowly.
