After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 due at time of entry, all fees included. Weights: Three Year Olds, 119 lbs., Older 124. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2012, allowed 3 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with four alternates. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2012. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the owner of the winner.

Footnotes

GOOD LORD quickly took command of a moderate early pace inside, rated to the three eighths pole, increased the pressure past the pole, maintained a slim advantage while contesting the turn, dueled clear into the lane and held well under steady encouragement to establish a track record. BANDBOX stalked the winner two deep, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, contested at a slight disadvantage through the final turn and dug in gamely from the top of the stretch though unable to catch that one. HURRICANE IKE rated just off the pace inside, gave chase leaving the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly. RUSSELL ROAD rated just off the early pace about the four path, started a bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, saved some ground through the final turn and ran evenly down the lane. MALIBU GLOW rated back from the early pace inside, picked up the chase past the seven sixteenths pole but showed no response while drifting outward through the lane. DYNAMITE BOB raced well back off the rail then widest through the lane.
