RANSOM THE MOON chased a bit off the rail then angled in entering the stretch, bid along the rail to gain the lead, inched away under urging and held. ROY H dueled outside a rival then between foes, was fanned out six wide into the stretch by the riderless horse then angled in and came back on. MOE CANDY stalked outside then off the rail, bid three deep leaving the turn, was fanned seven wide by the riderless horse into the stretch and also angled in and continued willingly. KOBE'S BACK a bit slow into stride, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch, split horses in the drive and was outfinished. SOLID WAGER allowed to settle off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DENMAN'S CALL chased a bit off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MAGIC TASTE broke through the gate before the start but barely came out, chased off the rail then outside on the turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and weakened. ST. JOE BAY had good early speed and dueled inside a foe but was kept off the rail by the riderless horse, was fanned out leaving the turn then angled back in for the stretch and weakened. DREFONG ducked in at the gap and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the early going before ruling DREFONG was the cause of his own trouble.
