PARTNERS STAR attended the pace three deep, tucked in entering the turn to save ground, shifted back to the outside to make her bid entering the stretch, and wore down SHADOW OF STORM under stern handling. SHADOW OF STORM prompted the pace along the inside, forged command leaving the turn, opened clear entering the stretch, battled willingly but was unable to resist the winner and grudgingly gave way. SPLASH OF ROSES was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the show. MORE OF THE BEST vied for the lead between horses, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. BREATH TAKING BREEZE broke slowly and saved ground to some avail. CRYSTAL HONOR bobbled at the start, raced three wide in the second flight and failed to respond.
