SWEETSOUTHERNMOON was away alertly, opened up a clear advantage shortly after the start, set the pace along the inside, drifted out into the lane and held an edge to the wire. BAUERS GOT HOURS pressed the pace along the inside, was gaining on the SWEETSOUTHERNMOON in the drive, could not wear that one down and finished gamely for the place. AND MUSIC CAME was unhurried early, raced between horses into the lane and was closing fast. ROYAL AND FLASHY trailed the field for six furlongs while saving ground, moved between horses into the stretch, angled in for room with a sixteenth of a mile to run and showed a good late bid. LITTLE DOLLAR raced three wide on the first turn in mid pack, offered a bid in mid stretch along the inside and failed to sustain his rally. MR. PORTER broke sharply, pressed the pace along the rail and tired in the drive. HALLWAY failed to threaten. CATEGORY SEVEN raced in mid pack along the outside and faded. BUILT TO PRECISION stalked the pace outside a rival, raced four wide into the stretch and tired.
