Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$150,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weights: Three Year Olds 116 lbs. Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 since January 9, allowed 2 lbs, \$45,000 since December 9, allowed 4 lbs, \$30,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. The Duncan F. Kenner Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2012-2013. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 23, 2013, with 15 nominations.

Footnotes

DELAUNAY moved up after the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the turn, accelerated clear in upper stretch and drew off under steady urging in a very quick time. GANTRY was well placed just off the pace, chased two then three wide on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive in upper stretch and was second best. GHOST IS CLEAR was rated off the pace, raced inside while given some free rein on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive at the quarter-pole, moved out near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. AMANECER DE ORO contested the pace on the inside of the winner, vied along the rail on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. SU CASA G CASA was coaxed along on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn and faded. HERO OF ORDER was reserved at the rear of the field, dropped back while off the rail early on the turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and faltered.
