BELL'S THE ONE was taken in hand early, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went three wide while roused on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, dropped in near the three-sixteenths under a drive, rallied to the lead inside the furlong marker and prevailed under strong urging. FORTUNATE GIRL was taken in hand early but went to the front, set the clear pace towards the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker, fought on well with the winner to the wire but missed while just able to hold the place. GAMBLIN TRAIN went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch, drifted out near the three-sixteenths, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to just miss the place. AMANDREA went around the first turn in the two path, was unhurried at the rear, rounded the far turn in the two path, was roused while three wide into the stretch then came under a drive and finished willingly for the last spot in the superfecta. MANDY BLUE was taken back early, rounded the first turn in the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. BEAUTIFUL BALLAD was taken in hand early, went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was rated just off the pace along the rail, came under urging near the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and tired. MISSMIZZ stumbled awkwardly at the start then was taken up between horses early, settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, came under the whip at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. (Rail at 16 Feet)
