Footnotes

HONKYTONK STOMP made a powerful surge to the front nearing the turn to quickly draw clear, continued from the three path to draw off in the bend then continued on strongly under steady hand urging to hold the margin while equaling the track record. KID RAMBO tracked the pace from four wide in the turn, continued outside into the lane and edged clear for the place while unable to threaten the winner. SONG OF HUMOR was along the inside through the turn, angled three wide into the lane and could make only a mild gain while gaining third. BULLFIGHT gained the lead from the gate and angled inside, was overtaken by the winner before reaching the turn then weakened in the lane. FIRST CLASS BRASS lacked a closing bid while four wide in the turn. FORENER angled out to move four wide into the lane but failed to rally. SKWHIRL was not a threat racing three wide. WINTER CLIMAX saved ground and was not a factor.
