Footnotes

RIVER BEAR rated behind the early speed from between rivals, commenced his bid widest on the turn, moved in beside ROYALRAP leaving the bend, took over just inside the furlong marker and quickly opened up under a drive. ROYALRAP broke inward, bumped solidly with FOUR LEFT FEET, vied for the lead just off the inside, moved clear on the turn, was challenged upper stretch, no match for RIVER BEAR but held second under steady handling. FOUR LEFT FEET squeezed hard from both sides at the start, chased from inside, angled out some on the bend, came three wide into the lane, gained third upper stretch then finished evenly. MY FEVER chased from inside, followed FOUR LEFT FEET'S path through the turn, moved inside that one midstretch, also leveled off the last eighth but proved easily best of the rest. MASTMAN displayed early speed from inside, could not stay with ROYALRAP on the turn, came off the rail some entering the lane and tired. CAJUN DIABLO broke inward, bumping DR. BUD, was a factor from outside on the backstretch but faded three wide on the bend. GREYHAWK broke outward, also bumping solidly with FOUR LEFT FEET, raced in the second flight between horses, quit early in the turn and returned bleeding from the nostrils. DR. BUD bumped at the break, trailed from outside, moved to the inside entering the turn, floated out again into the lane and was empty.
