FORT LOUDON dueled for the lead along the inside, gained a slim lead in deep stretch, then was all out to hold off SWAGGER JACK. The latter, stalked the pace along the rail, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on the winner just up for the place. BAHAMIAN SQUALL dueled for the lead outside FORT LOUDON to deep stretch and yielded. CLOSE IT OUT unhurried early, angled wide in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. GOOD MORNING DIVA rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and had no response when asked. TRAVELIN MAN chased the pace four wide around the turn, then gave way. FAIR WHIT was outrun. BIG GRANDPA vied for the lead three wide to midway of the turn and faltered.
