ROSE TO GOLD was allowed to settled while inside, saved ground on the far turn then scraped the rail in upper stretch, rallied along the inside and slipped through in late stretch to be best in the end. UNUSUAL WAY set a well handled pace from the start, drew off in upper stretch while under hard left handed urging but weakened in late stretch. CLASS INCLUDED chased the early pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but weakened in late stretch. MOON PHILLY was allowed to settled then raced three wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch but was no menace in late stretch. AND WHY NOT was unhurried early then raced on the inside on the far turn but was no threat in the stretch. AWESOME FLOWER was unhurried early then made a four wide bid on the far turn to upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. PHONYBOOKSNRECORDS was allowed to settled then faltered. DO YOU LIKE ME NOW was chasing the pace then was through after a half and stopped.
