Footnotes

FULLASATICK set the pace while racing off the rail, increased advantage on backstretch, responded when challenged by ORANGE BLOSSOM SP., then was kept to task to hold on over BEAUTY RUNS. The latter, never far back while between horses, eased out a bit in the stretch and was slowly gaining on the winner late. ORANGE BLOSSOM SP. prominently positioned along inside, pressed for the lead approaching final turn, forced the issue to the final stages and weakened. ECCENTRIC LADY trailed early, raced wide on the backstretch and the final turn, steadily improved position. GALWAY LADY, void of early speed, advanced in the stretch, but failed to reach contention. MISS DIAMOND MINE, outrun early while saving ground, eased between horses in the stretch and passed tired rivals. TURF ALERT reserved between horses early, edged closer after a half, dropped back in the drive. ZARB'S FANCY was not a factor between horses. SECRET SENORITA up close early along inside, tired nearing midstretch. SWEET ELEANOR wide in the stretch, was outrun. WILPITZ ROAD settled outside the early leaders, faltered after six furlongs.
