ITSINTHEPOST (FR) stalked the pace early, made a bid three wide in the final turn, shifted into the four path entering the lane, took command in the stretch and cleared the field in the final stages. CHARMING KITTEN trailed the field early on, shifted into the four path entering the lane, was bothered a bit in the upper stretch, altered widest, was rolling down the lane but was too late. BIGGER PICTURE tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the final turn with the lead but yielded late in the stretch run. DANISH DYNAFORMER was unhurried early, fanned into the five path entering the lane, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. RED RIFLE raced back early on, shifted into the three path in the far turn, came out in the upper stretch, made a bid but weakened late in the drive. BULLARDS ALLEY was well placed early, swung into the six path entering the lane and faded in the stretch run. CHOCOLATE RIDE set the pace early, angled off the rail in the final turn and gave way down the lane. INTERPOL chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the final turn, was bothered in the upper stretch and was empty late.
