XTRA HEAT broke alertly, set the pace along the rail, increased her advantage in midstretch and was under brisk urging in the drive. PRIZED STAMP stalked the pace two wide, reached a striking position entering the stretch, was no match for the winner but finished gamely to gain the place. KIMBRALATA, unhurried early, advanced along the rail in midstretch then failed to sustain her bid. GOLD MOVER chased the pace three wide and weakened in midstretch. PLATINUM TIARA saved ground on the turn, swung wide in midstretch and failed to be a factor. CITY FAIR raced wide and failed to rally. LIP SING'S AFFAIR, three wide between horses entering the turn, weakened. DIANEHILL (IRE) raced wide and dropped back early.
