WRANGLER was a bit unruly pre race, rated close up while off the rail, advanced between rivals under rating mid way on the turn, surged to command approaching the furlong marker and edged clear under strong handling. RUSTY SPUR went clear leaving the chute, set a quick pace towards the inside, was collared by the winner in upper stretch then continued gamely to hold the place. AFFIRMED SUCCESS broke alertly, stalked the pace four wide under some urging, continued four wide into the lane but could only muster a mild rally in the final furlong. LIGHTNING PACES was allowed to settle towards the inside, swung out five wide for the drive and finished with good energy. VOODOO lost ground five wide, remained a forward factor to the quarter pole then faded. EXCITING STORY was outrun early, came six wide into the lane and failed to menace. THE DEPUTY IS HOME broke a bit slowly, quickly reached contention along the inside, moved a bit closer along the rail into the lane then lacked any further response. HERE'S ZEALOUS was taken three wide leaving the chute, prompted the pace for five furlongs, tired, drifted out in the lane and was not abused in the final eighth of a mile.
