PETTIT'S QUEST stalked the winner two wide, failed to threaten that one and was best of the rest. ENDER WIGGIN, two wide between horses, was no threat. DANCIN RAHY bobbled at the break, saved ground and gave way. CLARK'S CLONE, three wide both turns, weakened. SHOW KING saved ground and dropped back.
