TALK'S CHEAP stalked two wide, gained the lead in midstretch and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. OLIVE FLU saved ground, lacked room in midstretch, angled three wide, closed under a hand ride and just missed. SMART GUY set the pace along the rail and weakened late. THUNDER FLASH, four wide into the first turn, raced three wide the far turn and tired. RAIRE STANDARD, wide the far turn, lacked a rally. HOLDITHOLDITHOLDIT, no factor, raced very wide leaving the far turn. PETTIT'S QUEST, three wide into the first turn, raced two wide the far turn and gave way.
