### Footnotes

MERENGUE assumed the early lead, set the pace near the rail and lasted under steady urging. QUEEN OF OZ prompted the pace outside the winner and held the place. MANOA, difficult to load into the starting gate, was in close quarters leaving the starting gate, checked in tight quarters entering the first turn, lost ground on both turns and failed to sustain her bid through the stretch. SAZARAC JAZZ saved ground stalking the leader and came up empty in the drive. TOO TOO DIVINE, three wide between rivals entering the stretch, lacked a rally. PRIMERCY, outrun, swung off the rail in upper stretch. GRAYCIOUS DANCER gave way along the rail. SUDDEN, checked lacking room entering the first turn, was outrun. MODEST GIRL broke slowly, raced wide and was outrun.
