PROMENADE GIRL moved easily to the early lead, went measured on soft fractions down the backside, may have been surprised when hooked then headed by BEAU WATCH at the three sixteenths pole, was quick to answer asserting late control showing much the best. BEAU WATCH away well stalked PROMENADE close traveling off the inside to the far turn, fired there collaring the pacesetter taking a short lived lead into upper stretch, would prove no match late keeping to task while saving place. FLY AWAY ANGEL sent up early tracking four wide through the backside, roused abreast rivals to edge to leaders on the far turn, extended at mid track was turned away in upper stretch dropping off PROMENADE GIRL finishing with even action. PRECOCIOUS KAT well placed early saved ground moving to PROMENADE GIRL vying at rail on the far turn, rebuffed at the quarter pole leveled off into lane posing no late threat. FAST AND FLUID kept close up early stalking the pace along the inside, roused hard into the far turn made no headway weakening at the head of the lane. AMBER NOTE dropped back early trailing the field to the half, gave a mild response on the far turn then wavered into upper stretch. NO AFFAIR had head turned missing the break, was hustled along the inside wearing out in upper stretch. PLUMLAKE LADY rushed wide to the backside would lose ground in pursuit giving way to upper stretch. PITANGA tucked inside early would fail to respond. TAPPIN FOR GOLD raced wide was done early.
