POCUS HOCUS prompted the early issue from the outside, moved closer on the final turn, responded well and prevailed late. CHRUSCIKI saved ground while posting the early fractions, dug in gamely during the stretch run and yielded grudgingly. FINAL ROUND stumbled at the start, was steadied behind rivals entering the clubhouse turn, advanced into the far turn, saved ground rounding the final bend then lacked the needed late response. ROUSING AGAIN well placed early from the outside, lodged a bid on the last turn and weakened in the drive. REBRIDLED DREAMS lacked a response. TREASURE'S DREAM steadied slightly while along the rail heading into the first turn, continued to save ground and had little left nearing the stretch.
