The host association's money to be divided 60% to the owner of the winning, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund money correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup money not awarded reverts to the Fund. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2006, 4 lbs. The winning owner to receive a trophy. Closed Sunday, July 30, 2006 with 17 nominations.





MO CUISHLE prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the final turn and drew clear nearing the quarter pole then responded to urging and drew away through the final furlong. GASIA broke in some, moved to the inside early, saved ground while close up and finished steadily while clear for the place. PEAK MARIA'S WAY bobbled at the break, set the early pace just off the inside, yielded the lead on the final turn then held willingly to gain a share. LAST ROMANCE four deep on the backstretch, lodged a bid outside on the final turn and lacked the needed stretch response. LOVE LOCKET three deep on the backstretch and between rivals, lacked the needed response and raced a bit wide turning for home. AMANDATUDE raced between foes on the backstretch and into the far turn, came up empty when asked and tired through the lane.
