PURE SENSATION vied inside throughout, lost the lead at the quarter pole but came again through the final furlong in a determined effort. VISION PERFECT vied three wide to the stretch, led narrowly at the eighth pole but was outfinished in a game showing. RAINBOW HEIR lacked speed, angled inside, moved back outside in the stretch and closed well in a blanket finish. IMPRIMIS urged four wide early, made a brief bid on the turn and continued willingly. BUCCHERO bumped about into the far turn, chased outside and was no threat. SMILING CAUSEWAY dueled between rivals, led narrowly at the quarter pole but proved empty in the stretch. POOL WINNER broke a step slowly, came out bumping rival into the far turn but weakened. SWELL dropped far behind and trailed throughout.
