SOUTHERN TOUR vied for the lead while three wide, was under good handling then was roused and drew off in mid stretch then was kept to pressure late. COASTALOTA was unhurried early then swung out six wide in upper stretch and closed with a rush to be gaining ground but was too late. DISCOS PEARL was unhurried early then saved ground on the turn, rallied along the inside in the stretch and was gaining ground to finish well. MISS PHOTOGENIC was saving ground on the turn then rallied three wide in upper stretch making a bid then came up empty in late stretch. SPIKED PUNCH was well placed while stalking the pace while four wide on the turn, made a strong bid to mid stretch then flattened out late. S'MORE SMOKE raced four wide on the turn then failed to menace. PINIANTE vied for the lead from the inside, was used up and stopped. TRUE ROSE was no factor. PRINCESS PANCHO vied for the early lead from between rivals, was used up and stopped.
