FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$10,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I race in 2014 or a Grade II race twice in 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I race in 2013 or a Grade II race in 2014 allowed 4 lbs.; a Grade III race in 2014 allowed 6 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 19, 2014 with 26 Nominations.

Footnotes

SWEET REASON drifted outward after stumbling at the start, making contact with LITTLE ALEXIS as a result, departed the backstretch from the three path but was closer to the rail for the majority of the way around the bend, swung outward entering the stretch, gradually getting maneuvered into the five path by the three-sixteenths marker, rider still applying a snug grip on the reins throughout the entire move, gained a clear seam to launch a rally and did so nearing the eighth pole, gained ground readily on the front runners, wrested away the lead with a few strides to spare before the wire and edged away, finishing under a strong hand ride. MISS BEHAVIOUR forwardly placed while between rivals during the very first stages of the event, got taken back by the rider, pressed the issue from the three path travelling around the turn, entered the stretch and got set down, battled hard down the lane to garner the place. LITTLE ALEXIS bumped from both sides, was squeezed at the start, made it over to the rail well before reaching the end of the homestretch, stayed put along the inside route until nearly the quarter pole, angled four wide into the stretch, came home with good energy down the center of the strip to take the show award. FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD was rushed up after the start to gain the lead, was at a considerable distance from off the rail down the backstretch, got placed along the inside nearing its end, cut the pace, feeling pressure from another pair parked out in paths two and three, got set down the drive home,

drifted two to three wide after entering the stretch, was moved back towards the inside shortly afterwards in response to a menacing move being made by SWEET WHISKEY at that juncture, proceeded a bit erratically thereafter, relinquished with under a sixteenth remaining. SWEET WHISKEY kept watch on the front runners from near the inside, had sufficient room to unleash a rally along the rail corridor and did so cutting the corner, momentarily loomed a threat at the end of the furlong grounds, had her lane tightened up a bit with about an eighth to go for several strides, flattened out in the final seventy yards. THANK YOU MARYLOU stalked the pace from the two path, failed to menace. TEA TIME bumped from between rivals at the start, was four wide and under encouragement past the five-sixteenths marker, made no headway. BIRD MAKER bumped soundly at the start, was three wide at the half mile pole, never reached a contending position. SOUTHERN HONEY contested for the lead from between rivals during the run around the bend before giving way. STREET STORY washy at the gate, was between rivals entering the turn, made no impact.
