SONG OF THE MOMENT stalked the early pace, came off the rail and rallied to take the lead on the turn, inched clear in mid stretch and was under steady pressure late. ROSANDA was allowed to settle, rallied two wide to the stretch and was gaining late. SYCUAN chased the pace three wide but lacked a closing response. FLOATIN ON XTACY saved ground but was outrun. GOLDEN CAROUSEL was allowed to settle but lacked a rally in the drive. CANCION DEL VALLE had the best speed, set the pace to the five sixteenths then gave way. JUNE LADY was very wide throughout. CREDIT ME CAROL was not a factor. BEE BEAUTY was through early, eased in the stretch but walked off after crossing the finish line.
