SLEWSBOX pressed the early pace, raced up outside of PHAENNA and three wide to duel to the stretch, responded to vigorous handling in the drive and held. CARSON JEN was allowed to settle, rallied two then three wide to the stretch, responded to pressure to deep stretch but could not catch the winner. PHAENNA dueled while racing well off the rail to the stretch, dug in leaving the quarter pole but weakened late. HARVEST GIRL stalked the pace while saving ground to the stretch, responded to pressure in upper stretch to loom a factor then was outfinished in the final sixteenth. ISIT CLASS was allowed to settle, saved ground to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BRITE GIRL broke in a tangle and was outrun to the turn, tried to rally leaving the quarter pole but finished evenly. IMAGE OF GLORY was allowed to settle off the leaders, was caught three then four wide to the stretch and had little to offer once straightened. FAHANA was not a factor.
