Footnotes

AMERICAN DYNASTY sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, drew off on the second turn when asked to pick up her pace and was not menaced while kept to her task. BAREFOOT DYANA, five wide on the first turn when within striking distance, raced four wide on the second turn and lodged a mild bid for the place. SNAPPY LITTLE TUNE, reserved early off the inside, was pocketed approaching the stretch, was angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. CLASSY LADY M pressed the early pace three wide, moved to the inside on the second turn but tired in the drive. TRUE LIES, outrun early three wide, was three wide on the second turn and rallied belatedly. SWEET ELOISE, unhurried early, made a mild gain off the inside into the second turn, was angled out entering the stretch but had no late bid. KARATE MISS, reserved off the inside, was angled out four wide on the second turn but had nothing left in the drive. LACE CURTAIN IRISH, outrun early, raced four wide on the second turn and was not a factor. TITLE TO THE MINT, four wide on the first turn when a forward factor, stayed well for six furlongs and faded. SILKY OAKS, within striking distance inside, was through after five furlongs. THREE FANFARES, outrun early inside, was no factor.
