QUINTON'S GOLD saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was all out at the wire. PROFOUND SECRET went three wide leaving the turn, closed fast and was steadily gaining to just miss. RIO ORO set a pressured pace, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. KOMAX lacked early speed and gained through the stretch in a rail bid. NANCY'S JOKER raced mid pack, went wide for the drive and finished well. CODED MESSAGE eased out on the turn to bid between horses and leveled off in the drive. COOL COMPOSURE broke sharply, fell back to lag and failed to rally. FREESPOOL pressed the pace to the turn, swung five wide and faltered. ROCKY BAR stalked the pace to the turn and gave way. NO CAL BREAD was not a threat.
