Footnotes

ATTITUDE E RACER prompted the early pace four wide, vied in the stretch, then surged clear and was best late. MOSTLY DUST set the early pace drawing clear racing off the inside, was challenged in deep stretch and failed to last. CHUCHULUCO forced the early pace three wide, lacked a gain late and flattened in the drive. OUR CHOICE was outrun early racing seven wide down the backstretch, began to rally in the stretch, drifted in five wide and closed late. HUNTING DIXIE was unhurried early racing off the rail, sustained a brief bid then weakened. AFFLUENT BOY was outrun early then placed a steady effort six wide. FOURTEEN KT. GOLD was void of early speed getting away slowly and placed a mild effort late. ROLL ON DIEGO laced early speed racing seven wide, angled four wide and lacked a gain late. BEAU WIZER raced mid pack and lacked a closing response. DESERT HENNESSY chased the early leaders, made a middle move then gave way. LOTA TALENT retreated steadily. DOMS FLASH was off slow, then hustled up along the rail, was used up early and stopped.
