YOU KNOW I KNOW chased the pace outside a rival around the first turn, moved up between horses into the second turn, angled outside the leader at the top of the stretch, took over the lead at the sixteenth pole and drew clear late. HUNTSVILLE moved up three deep into the second turn, took a short lead while three wide around the turn, maintained the advantage in midstretch, was run down in the final sixteenth but was a clear second at the wire. DESORMAIS saved ground chasing the pace, came out for the stretch drive, passed tiring foes and was a clear third at the wire. WINDS OF DUBAI settled into the first turn and saved ground, chased off the rail down the backstretch and three deep on the second turn, remained outside in the lane and did not rally. YES IT'S SNOWING dueled for the lead on the outside then between horses and weakened in the final furlong. MAJOR MAGIC dueled for the lead on the inside for six furlongs and also weakened.
