TEDDY'S PROMISE had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, inched away into the turn, kicked clear, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and held gamely under some urging and good handling. JUDY IN DISGUISE (GB) prompted the pace between horses then outside the winner, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, was between horses past midstretch and continued willingly to be second best. RUMOR bobbled at the start to be away a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and just held third. MINDS EYES chased three deep on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and just missed the show. THERE IS NO LIMIT was in a good position chasing the pace between rivals early then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. WARREN'S BLOSSOM pressed the pace three deep then stalked off the rail a half mile out, dropped back between horses early on the turn and weakened.
