BLISSTIKUS settled off the duel in the two path, advanced two wide down the backstretch, bid between foes into the far turn, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, drew clear turning for home, dug in late and repelled DIMPLES' final challenge. DIMPLES was unhurried while racing three wide early, moved outside of the winner down the backstretch, bid three wide between foes around the far turn, continued on his left lead in upper stretch, switched leads leaving the sixteenth pole, rallied and came up just short. MARGARET HIGH lacked speed speed in the two path, advanced four wide around the far turn and flattened out a bit in the lane. DORA DORA lagged inside, went three wide around the far turn and rallied belatedly. FLIRTING SONG failed to menace while racing two wide. JAX AND JILL pressed the pace two wide around the first turn, took the lead near the half-mile pole, drew clear midway down the backstretch but tired around the far turn. LANDON DID IT was outrun inside. SLIMMING IN BLACK raced two wide and never factored. I DID IT THAT TIME set the pace along the rail and stopped nearing the far turn.
