POINTS OFFTHEBENCH stalked outside, bid four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch, took a short lead and drifted inward in midstretch, continued to drift in, fought back through the final sixteenth and gamely prevailed under energetic handling. GOLDENCENTS pulled his way along between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, continued inside into the turn, swung out leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid outside the winner a sixteenth out and continued gamely to the wire but could not get by. JIMMY CREED prompted the pace between horses then outside a rival, bid three deep between foes leaving the turn and into the stretch, put a head in front into the stretch and held third. MAJESTIC CITY chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COMMA TO THE TOP had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked into the turn, re-bid between horses a quarter mile out and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. COACH BOB bobbed slightly at the start, went up between horses to duel for the lead, inched away briefly early on the turn, angled in, fought back inside leaving the turn but weakened in the stretch.
