ENCHANTED RIVER settled off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn, hesitated coming to the quarter-pole, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied on the rail, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker then edged clear under good handling. FORT PRADA bumped with a rival at the start then dropped back, raced off the rail into the turn then dropped close to the inside, angled out under a drive in upper stretch, gained into the final furlong, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and finished with good energy near the outside of the course to secure the place. ZIP HER UP was urged along while off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the show. LAHAINA set the pace under pressure, vied along the rail on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and weakened. LA SORELLA raced towards the rear, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. CONSPIRED showed speed between rivals then chased the pace, raced in the two path on the turn, pursued the leader into the final furlong and tired. INDYGO STAR bumped with FORT PRADA at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch and capitulated. TAMAZULA broke a half-step slow, saved ground at the back and was no factor. GIA DIGZIT pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and gave way. (Rail at 15 Feet)
