WHISKEY GINGER stalked a bit off the rail, came out three wide into the stretch, bid outside rivals in the drive, gained the lead under left handed urging past midstretch and won clear. REMESSES had speed a bit off the fence then dueled inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner but held second. OREJAS dueled between horses then outside the runner-up into and on the turn, fought back between foes in midstretch and bested the others. GATO DOLCE stalked the pace inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. COLONIAL POWER saved ground chasing the pace throughout and could not offer the necessary response. VOW'S SON chased five wide then four wide on the turn, angled in off the rail into the stretch and weakened. CONTENTO stalked four wide between horses then three deep into the turn, angled to the inside leaving the turn and also weakened. TRUE FORCE settled off the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. PRESS GAME prompted the pace four wide then stalked into the turn, came three wide into the stretch and gave way. RUSH TO PARADISE broke a bit slowly, chased between horses then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. WHATA GUESS dueled three deep between horses, stalked into the turn, angled in and dropped back leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch. SUNSET GRILL tried to rear and was off slowly and squeezed back, pulled hard between horses chasing the pace, dropped back off the rail on the turn and was done early and was eased in the stretch.
