TWO SHAKES cleared the field after the start and angled to rail, then stalked the pace setter, tipped two wide into the lane, reached the lead in upper stretch and was driven out to the wire. PURPLE FLOWERS vied three wide, got outpaced while drifting out into the lane, came again and got up for place in the late stages. SUN DRESS cleared the field into the first turn, maintained her advantage through the far turn, but was challenged in upper stretch and yielded. MUSIC MAJOR sat far back three wide, angled in down the backstretch, split rivals around the far turn and rallied belatedly. TWEETY SHOW raced midpack, pulled three wide between horses into the first turn, tipped to the five path into the lane, rallied and stayed on but didn't threaten the leaders. BOURBON ENDOWMENT tracked while saving ground, raced three wide between rivals down the backstretch, but failed to quicken in upper stretch. TROPICAL WAVE rated far back, saved ground and offered a mild inside gain in the late stages. ABSORB saved ground to no avail. IN A FLURY trailed

two to upper stretch and did not menace. MORE COWBELL was up close between horses early, shifted four wide into the lane, but weakened. LAWNMOWER raced up close four wide into the first turn, but was scrubbed on and faltered passing the seven-sixteenths pole. SEARCH FOR SAMMY was caught four wide around the first turn, then faltered outside of rivals down the backstretch and made no impact.
