THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, February 16. \$400,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings.

ETE INDIEN quickly cleared on top and crossed over to the inside heading toward the first turn, set the pace and saved ground down the backstretch, widened advantage moving through the far turn then prompted at the quarter pole, responded willingly and drew off authoritatively while drifting wider under right handed pressure through the lane. CANDY TYCOON raced on the inside around the first turn then settled off the pace to the far turn, coaxed around

the far turn then advanced to race outside of AS SEEN ON TV in the final furlong, got carried out wider by rival but stayed on gamely and captured place. AS SEEN ON TV veered out at the start then raced in range along the inside through early stages, ridden along to maintain tempo going by the half mile marker then put to a drive around the final turn, ran on under steady pressure into the lane, shifted out wider in late stages and got edged for the runner up spot. SHOTSKI raced widest while rated through early stages, launched an outside bid around the final turn, moved up closer and stayed on trying to capture a share, got carried out wider in late stages and lacked the late needed kick to gain position. COUNTRY GRAMMER lost footing at the start and raced in the back, continued unhurried in the last flight, prompted along the outside and raced widest in the lane and had a mild improve. MASTERDAY secured inside position on the first turn, continued to rate while saving ground through middle stages, hustled the rail around the far turn, cut the corner and gained position but failed to sustain bid and gave way. THE FALCON was unhurried and saved ground down the backstretch, was put to a drive two to three wide entering top stretch and lacked a needed rally. GEAR JOCKEY got bumped a bit at the start then was forwardly placed around the first turn, stalked the pacesetter to the far turn, raced in aim for the lead near the seven sixteenths pole but could not advance on eventual winner then steadily weakened. LIAM'S LUCKY CHARM raced in range and tracked the pace along the outside through early stages, urged to go after the leader racing three path entering the far turn but could not move on and faded. DENNIS' MOMENT raced between foes not too far off the pace in early backstretch, was called upon to advance near the half mile marker but had no response and dropped back.
