THE BEAUTY'S TALE was allowed to settle early while three wide on the backstretch, made a bid three wide on the far turn, hit the front entering the stretch and was clear past the eighth pole, then held sway late to prove best, driving. KYNANCE (IRE) was reserved early and raced three wide on the backstretch, was sent down around the five sixteenths pole, came into the stretch six wide and rallied well, but was too late while second best. COMPLETE was void of early speed and raced three wide on the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide while starting to unwind, then had to alter course in midstretch, angled out late and closed fast. SONG RIVER stalked the early pace three wide, made a bid three wide past the quarter pole to vie for command, but could not sustain that bid while fading late. HALAMA was rated off the front two and raced on the inside on the backstretch, moved into contention on the turn, but was shut off past the quarter pole, swung out four wide at the top of the stretch but was empty. DISTINCTIVE FLOWER set a fast pace on the inside for six furlongs then gave way.
