WHITMORE last to leave, crept up closer along the inside, continued to bide his time while saving ground through the turn, eased out into the two path when straightened for home, kicked down the leader and won going away. MR. JAGERMEISTER broke sharp, set the pace inside, shook clear into the lane, proved no match for the winner late, comfortably held the place. WENDELL FONG away in good order, raced within striking distance outside, three path through the turn, along for the show while widest in the drive, no threat to the top pair. BOLDOR fell back to trail after the start, went evenly in the drive to make little impact. SHARE THE UPSIDE pressed the runner up off the inside, was losing touch with that one into the lane when brushed slightly by the winner in upper stretch, weakened, lost the show late.
