By subscription of \$750 each which should accompany the nomination; \$5,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$6,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$11,250 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, November 20, 2021 with 22 Nominations.

AMERICANREVOLUTION settled just off the pace, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, went two then three wide under strong encouragement on the turn, was driven into upper stretch, bumped with a foe inside the three-sixteenths, made a bid near the furlong marker, took the lead into the final sixteenth and prevailed under strong urging. FOLLOWING SEA moved up to get the lead, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked with five-sixteenths to run then headed at the quarter-pole, fought back gamely inside of foes and regained the lead, was headed by the winner into the final sixteenth and missed while clear for the place. PLAINSMAN was hard held off the pace, came under urging while moving from the inside to the two path on the turn, moved out into upper stretch, bumped with a rival inside the three-sixteenths, chased between horses into the final furlong, steadied briefly while in tight at the sixteenth-pole and safely secured the show while unable to go with the top two. OLYMPIAD had INDEPENDENCE HALL clip his heels outside the three-quarter pole, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked three then four wide on the turn then driven six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CODE OF HONOR settled at the rear of the field, was roused two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, drifted out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. GINOBILI prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, vied in the two path on the turn, took a short advantage at the quarter-pole, battled on even terms for the lead while under a drive into the final furlong and tired. INDEPENDENCE HALL clipped heels outside the three-quarter pole, was reserved off the pace, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths, went three to four wide on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and failed to threaten. PIPELINE veered out at the start, settled on the outside, was asked while four then five wide on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and faltered. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH
