ALYDIVA stalked the pace early on, raced along the inside in the far turn, was in the three path into the lane, made a bid down the lane under a long drive and won the nod at the wire. SURREALIST broke out at the start, set the pace early, was off the rail into the lane, under a long drive in the final stages and was out-nodded at the wire. TEXAS SHUFFLE was bothered at the start, chased the pace early, raced four wide along the far turn, was in the five path into the lane, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. CADENCIA was bumped at the start and raced back early on, was in the three path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch from the inside but hung in the final stages. CERULEAN tracked the pace early on, was in the four path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. ROBIN'S FANTASY was bumped at the start, chased the pace early, was off the rail into the lane, altered to the inside once in the stretch and flattened out late in the drive. ELLE EST FORTE raced four wide along the first turn, five wide along the far turn, was in the five path

into the lane and improved position. FLYING GEM broke slowly and was bothered at the start, raced in the three path into the lane. PEARL GIRL chased the pace early on, raced three wide along the far turn, was in the four path into the lane and leveled off down the lane. SOMA was never a threat. ANTHROPOLOGY hit the gate at the start and was done early. THE GINGER QUEEN (IRE) was bumped at the start and through after a half.
