GINGRICH came out at the start and raced back early on, was on the inside along the first turn, in the five path into the lane, rallied down the lane, drove past the leaders three wide and cleared the field in the final stages. OVERANALYTICAL was bumped at the start, raced from between horses along the first turn, pressed the early pace, was in the two path into the lane, inched ahead near the eighth pole but yielded in the late stages. WAKE SURF came out at the start, set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and faltered late in the stretch run. WATCH THE MUSIC raced in the three path along the first turn, trailed the field early on, was in the four path into the lane, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the final stages. STAR SHOPPING raced from between horses along both turns, chased the early pace, exchanged bumps with STEINBECK down the lane from the two path and weakened late in the drive. STEINBECK stalked the pace early on, was on the inside into the lane, exchanged bumps with STAR SHOPPING down the lane along the inside and weakened late in the drive. MINNESOTA READY was unhurried early on, raced in the three path entering the lane and improved position late in the stretch. RULE THE EMPIRE was well placed early on, raced from between horses along both turns, was in the four path into the lane and faded late in the stretch

run. RUM 'N TONIC tracked the pace early while three wide, was pulled along the backstretch, settled along the far turn, was in the three path into the lane and empty late in the stretch drive. AFTERNOON ANEJO was never a threat. MAGILLA was done early.
