ZIPPIN GIGI set a clear pace along the inside, met MARQUEE RIDE's bid into the far turn, shook away from that foe at the five sixteenths pole, drew clear in upper stretch, and lasted to the wire. OVERANALYTICAL stalked three wide, chased the clear leader without progressing through upper stretch, produced a late kick to narrow the leader's margin in the finals furlong, attempted a late bid, but ran out of ground while requiring mild rider-correction from lugging in on the wire. MARQUEE RIDE stalked the clear leader two wide, bid into the far turn, but was turned away and failed to keep pace at the five sixteenths pole, and tired. HADDASSAH'S DEVIL tracked the pace in the two path, drifted outwardly in midstretch, but kept on mildly to maintain a minor reward. LIONESQUE laid off of the pace in the two path around the turns, and failed to threaten. GRAN MUCHACO rated far off of the pace along the

inside, then two wide around the far turn before tipping to the three path in upper stretch and stayed on between horses late, but missed reaching a minor share. LUCKY CRUSADER trailed around the first turn, then took the far turn three wide and made little impact. MRTANDROSEYSBOY took a stuttered step at the start, raced far off of the pace in the three to two path around the first turn, and failed to factor. OLD FORTY FIVE broke slowly, recovered to be forwardly placed two wide and between horses around the first turn, but weakened in to the far turn, and was done early.
