THRIVE sent for the lead, cleared and angled in around the first turn, padded the lead on the backstretch, remained comfortably ahead into the stretch, then widened under hand urging and coasted in late. WHISKEY VISION was off alertly then dropped back and chased four wide around the first turn, traveled three deep on the second bend, came four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. KING ROB forwardly placed four then three wide on the clubhouse turn, closest in pursuit up the backstretch, gained some ground around the far turn in the three path, flattened in the lane and saved the show. MISSING MAURICE chased along the inside, angled out three to four wide on the far turn and improved position. CROSS INDIAN chased three wide on the first turn, outside a rival on the backstretch, rounded the far turn between rivals, drifted out midstretch and had to be corrected, then failed to rally after. BIG EVENT lost his path when the leader angled in on the first turn, tracked out of range in the middle stages, coaxed along the rail into the stretch and failed to rally. MONGOLIAN BONUS raced in the second flight, moved out on the backstretch, went five wide into the far turn, angled down to the three path and made no impact. AWKWARD MORNING stumbled leaving the gate, raced four to five wide around both turns from off the pace and was never a factor. SYNC trailed in the three path early, remained three wide into the stretch and never got involved.
