REDLINE raced up close on the inside before dueling for command, fought into and around the turn, carried the lead into the stretch, battled with the runner-up through the final furlong and held that rival at bay. AMERICAREDWHITEBLU stalked off the rail, angled down to the inside then back out and bid outside the top pair at the quarter pole, challenged REDLINE through the lane but could not get by. SHORTMAN chased widest to the turn, went four to five wide around the bend and gained the show. DANCE COMPANY got bumped leaving the gate, unhurried at the back of the pack, went three wide into the turn, angled to the rail around the bend and got edged for the show honors. FUNKENSTEIN got forced into rival leaving the gate, traveled four wide into the turn racing at the back, angled down to the two paths and failed to menace. THRIVE broke in and bumped rival, had his path taken early, coaxed between rivals and went up to duel for command outside a rival leaving the backstretch, fought for command around the turn then lost touch past the quarter pole and gave way in the lane. MANDO bumped from outside and forced in leaving the gate, chased three to four wide into the stretch, checked between rivals past the eighth pole and weakened. FINGLAS LAD broke well, raced up close outside rivals early then chased the top pair into the turn, went four wide around the bend and weakened. CALDER VALE away quickly, forwardly placed between rivals then got put in tight quarters and steadied at the nine-sixteenths pole, dropped back into and around the turn and came up empty.
