BEIGNET got bumped leaving the gate, went up to clear and crossed over, opened up a comfortable lead in the middle stages, challenged by a pair of rivals midway around the far turn, clung to a narrow advantage at the quarter pole then relinquished command late on the bend, fought back inside WHISKEY BLUE and regained the lead with a sixteenth remaining and kept on gamely to the line. WHISKEY BLUE stalked in the two path early, moved out further on the backstretch, range up three deep on the far turn and headed the leader approaching the quarter pole, took over leaving the bend, duelled with BEIGNET in the stretch, lost command at the sixteenth pole but was clearly second best. STARSHIP SKY brushed leaving the gate, chased three wide around the first turn, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, drifted out on the far turn and gained the show. AWESOME PAMELA got bumped between rivals in the beginning, tracked three wide early, went three to four wide on the far turn and kept on to round out the superfecta. SMILIN EVIE stalked three wide around the first turn, bid between on the second bend, fought to the eighth pole and weakened. ROMAN EMPRESS got bumped on both sides at the start and took up between rivals shortly after, chased four then three wide outside a rival on the clubhouse turn, angled in on the final bend and lacked further response. DASHING DEMI unhurried on the inside early, trailed two wide into the drive and tired. LIBERALISM pulled up on the first turn and walked off. HAND-TIMED.
