INNER TURF FOR FOUR- YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination. \$4,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade or Group One race at a mile or over in 2022-23 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade or Group Two race at a mile or over in 2022-23 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Grade or Group Three race at a mile or over in 2022-23 allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, April 29, 2023 with 16 Nominations. (Rail at 9 feet).

RED KNIGHT was taken under a tight hold early, rounded the first turn in the two path under snug restraint, was reserved with cover at the rear, moved closer near the nine-sixteenths, traveled three wide around the far turn, was roused four wide into the stretch, rallied outside to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. SOLDIER RISING (GB) was reserved under restraint in the two path, shifted three wide late on the final turn then was roused, chased the leaders in the stretch and finished with good courage to just get the place. STRONG TIDE established a forward position early while in hand, rounded the first turn in the three path, prompted the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole then took a short lead into upper stretch, battled on even terms for the advantage while between foes into the final furlong, fought on into the final sixteenth and was outfinished by the winner then just missed the place while narrowly able to get the show. HOWE STREET was rated just off the pace on the inside, drafted behind foes on the far turn, was given his cue outside the quarter-pole, came out into upper stretch, chased behind the leaders into the final furlong, moved out from behind those foes nearing the sixteenth-pole and also finished with good courage but just missed the trifecta. WARREN POINT (GB) was loaded with a loading blanket and a blindfold, kept the blindfold on while waiting on the start, had the assistant starter remove the blindfold as the latch was sprung, came out awkwardly while leaning out against the gate and was off a bit slow, traveled three wide under stout restraint around the opening bend, was reserved outside but with the benefit of cover, advanced after being removed from cover near the five-eighths pole, was let out three wide on the far turn, gained to make a bid nearing the quarter-pole, fought on even terms for the lead into the final furlong, vied into the final sixteenth and was out-kicked then just missed the minor awards. CHANNEL MAKER went to the front, showed the way on the inside while in hand, was asked a bit with

three furlongs to run then roused for more outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage into upper stretch, fought inside of two foes into the final furlong, kept on well to the finish but was also out-kicked. VERSTAPPEN was reserved under a hold on the inside, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. VALUE ENGINEERING went three wide on the first turn, was rated outside but with the benefit of cover, went around the far turn in the two path, was roused late on that bend and came up empty.
