PATCH ADAMS prompted three deep, vied around the turn, sparred with a single inner rival into the lane, took charge in upper stretch, kicked away under a drive in midstretch and was put to wraps late. CANT STOP MUNNINGS stalked four wide, then chased willingly through the lane to gain place late. SHOGUN settled off of the pace along the inside, chased in the two path in upper stretch, angled out to the four path with a sixteenth to go and progressed to reach show at the wire. ZAT'S THE ONE leaned out and brushed a foe leaving the gate, led narrowly two wide and between vying rivals into the turn, sparred with only his outer counterpart into the lane, proved no match for that one in upper stretch and weakened. MOGORDY brushed an inner rival at the

start, vied for the lead with a pair of outer rivals into the turn, gave way to them with five sixteenths to go, yet shifted off of the inside while sustaining stride into the final furlong, kept on to rebid for show between horses at the wire but missed. ANEW was brushed by an inner rival at the start, pursued from midpack three wide and between horses, chased in the four path into upper stretch, leaned inwardly in the final furlong and lacked a bid. DIXIE DEVIL raced off of the pace in the four path, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch and failed to menace. NATIVE RUNNER broke a step slow before being brushed by an outer rival at the start, saved ground well back, but to no avail. MASTER MULE chased forwardly in the two path and faded between horses turning for home. MISSED THE TURN tracked five wide and tired. RIPPED pursued six wide early on then weakened in the five path around the turn and was found to have bled. TRAITOUR broke slowly, lagged behind and showed little.
